The Role:

Reporting to the Style Library Finance Director, the role of Analytics Manager is to transform the quality and quantity of Business Information using the QlikView BI platform.

The Analytics Manager will be responsible for turning data into information which will allow users to gain business insight. You will also formulate strategy of how we use this data including designing, implementing and supporting other BI solutions.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure the production environment is available for use by the business on a daily basis with minimal downtime
- Maintain and improve the analytics environment so that it is well governed and connected in multiple areas
- Lead the management of analytics projects using appropriate frameworks including QlikView development best practice
- Work with stakeholders to define the scope of analytics solutions and desired outcomes to feed in to technical design
- Work with stakeholders to create a demonstrable return on investment and business case to assist in prioritisation of activities
- Work with the FD and MD to ensure appropriate prioritisation takes place
- Appropriately transfer developments and processes to business as usual
- Lead the end-to-end technical development of QlikView applications and other solutions including data extraction, modelling, user interface and more
- Lead the development of QlikView administration skills within the business between the Finance team and Group Systems including day-to-day servicing
- Train and support key analytics technical super users within Finance and IT
- Identify and lead training for roll out of applications
- Ongoing financial & analytical support to Style Library finance team
